Tuition fees are revised annually. The increase is normally between 2% and 7% and is applied annually to each year of the programme, including for continuing students. Tuition fees for UK undergraduate students on the BMus programme are aligned with the maximum tuition fee cap set by the UK government. Figures in brackets are the fees for Overseas BMus students continuing to Year 3 or 4; or Overseas Doctoral students continuing to Year 3 or beyond in 25/26.
